

# Infant and Toddler Programs

## UCP's Infant and Toddler Program Hours:

- Morning Only (8:30 - 11:30 a.m.)
- School Day (8:30 a.m. - 2:30 p.m. with 1:30 p.m. dismissal on Wednesdays)
- Full Day (Hours Vary)

## Curriculum:

UCP of Central Florida uses The Creative Curriculum® and High Reach for our Infant and Toddler Program. The Creative Curriculum® for Infants, Toddlers & Twos is a play-based program. Its focus is on creating intentional and developmentally appropriate environments for children to guide them to school readiness.

The goals of the curriculum are

1. Social/Emotional Development: To learn about self and others by trust known, caring adults, regulate own behavior, manage own feelings, respond to other's feelings with growing empathy, play with other children, learn to be a member of a group and use personal care skills.
2. Physical Development: Demonstrate basic gross motor skills and basic fine motor skills.
3. Cognitive Development: Sustain attention, understand how objects can be used, show a beginning understanding of cause and effect, show a beginning understanding that things can be grouped, use problem-solving strategies and engage in pretend play.
4. Language Development: Develop receptive and expressive language, participate in conversations, enjoy books and being read to, show an awareness of pictures and print and experiment with drawing and writing.

The High Reach Curriculum is:

## Ratios and Group Sizes:

(Note: Ratios and class size may vary on the individual needs of the student)

Birth - 12 months	8 children	Four children to one staff (4:1)
12 months - 36 months (Toddler Room)	12 to 14 children	Four/five children to one staff (4/5:1)

## Eligibility:

The UCP Infant/Toddler program serves children ages 6 weeks to 3 years with and without disabilities.

## Program Costs:

- Children with an Individual Family Support Plan (IFSP) with “Classroom” as an eligible service - FREE Tuition - Generally two or four mornings a week (before/after school additional charge)
- Children without IFSP/Private Pay - \$150 - \$175 (depending on location)
- UCP also accepts 4C Subsidized childcare vouchers
- Early Head Start funding for eligible children
- Before care/After care - \$60 per week
