Executive Committee

The YEC will aim to engage with UCP in the following ways:

- Become familiar with UCP services and campuses through tours, activities, and volunteerism
- Connect friends and future donors to UCP's mission through friendraising & fundraising events and campaigns
- Provide feedback on UCP programs, including ways to improve or enhance services & engage new marketing strategies
- > Host 2 fundraising events and 2 volunteer projects throughout the year
- > Participate in UCP activities volunteer projects, special events, and fundraisers

UCP will aim to invest in the YEC in the following ways:

- Provide opportunities for networking with board members & other friends (donors and supporters) of UCP
- Provide training to become future UCP board members and future executives within their industry (professional development opportunities)
- Provide meaningful ways for YEC members to contribute to UCP services & programs (through volunteerism and special events)
- Provide consistent communication with Development Team and Agency Leadership

Membership & Commitment

The YEC will consist of 15-21 total members between the ages of 20-40. Participation from each member is vital to the success of this group. YEC members are asked to commit to a minimum two-year term and make the following commitments during their term:

- Attend at least 80% of the Council Meetings each UCP fiscal year (July 1st June 30th)
- Connect to UCP media and regularly share posts/opportunities with their networks: e-newsletter, Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, LinkedIn
- Promotion of UCP's mission within the community an ambassador of the organization sharing the story!
- Complete annual volunteer registration process, allowing members the ability to come on campus and interact with UCP kids. This process includes an application, a background check, and orientation/training.
- Contribute annual membership dues of \$100
- > Consider a leadership role within YEC for the second year
- Participate in executing two YEC fundraising events each year (Putt for Brighter Futures and Toast to Brighter Futures)
- Participate in at least two UCP organized fundraising events as a donor/attendee or volunteer
- > Participate in at least one Book Buds event each semester and bring friends
- > Participate in at least one UCP organized community relations project
- > Recruit at least one potential new member per calendar year
- Bring energy and enthusiasm!

Leadership Roles

Young Executive Committee is a volunteer-based group of young professionals and is supported by UCP's staff. The following leadership positions are one-year terms.

🔊 Chair

The Chair position is a one-year term, transitioning from the Chair-Elect position. The Chair serves as the leader of the group and sets the annual goals with UCP staff prior to stepping into the position. The Chair leads YEC meetings and acts as liaison to UCP staff. This position will be supported by UCP's Community Engagement Manager.

Project Manager for Putt for Brighter Futures

This position will oversee all event management and fundraising efforts related to Putt for Brighter Futures. These aspects include sponsorships, auction/chance to win, ticket sales, venue selection, promotion, and more. A successful Project Manager will be skilled at motivating the rest of the committee to engage in the event and delegating tasks/responsibilities. This position will be supported by UCP's Director of Special Events.

Project Manager for Professional Development/ Board Relations

This position will work with the UCP Board of Directors and other community contacts to coordinate networking and professional development opportunities for the rest of the committee. This position will be supported by UCP's Senior Director of Development.

Chair-Elect

The Chair-Elect is a two-year commitment, transitioning into the Chair position in year two. The Chair-Elect assists the Chair and is responsible for communicating with the committee. The Chair-Elect will send out meeting agendas one week before a scheduled meeting and meeting minutes one week after the meeting. This position will be supported by UCP's Community Engagement Manager.

Project Manager for Toast to Brighter Futures

This position will oversee all event management and fundraising efforts related to Toast for Brighter Futures. These aspects include sponsorships, auction/chance to win, ticket sales, venue selection, promotion, and more. A successful Project Manager will be skilled at motivating the rest of the committee to engage in the event and delegating tasks/responsibilities. This position will be supported by UCP's Director of Special Events.

Project Manager for Volunteer Projects

This position will coordinate 2 volunteer events specifically for the committee to participate in throughout the year. In addition, this position will directly manage the YEC's involvement in Help for the Holidays. This position will be supported by UCP's Community Engagement Manager.
