Internship Description:

Our internship programs include Level I and Level II opportunities designed specifically for students seeking an Education degree in a university teacher preparation program.

Our internship participants provide support to teachers in an inclusive classroom setting including implementing instructional programs, assessing student performance, and other tasks as needed by the supervising teacher, while completing the requirements of their education internship.

Qualifications:

A student pursuing a degree in Education

Internship Tasks:

- Implements lessons plan including instructional groups per teacher's direction.
- Leads small and whole group of instruction for students.
- Assists teacher in writing lesson plans and Individual Education Plans.
- Assists in planning and developing/setting up instructional materials for classroom.
- Assist in administering assessments/progress monitoring.
- *Other Duties as Assigned*

Education & Training:

- **Required:** 3 years of college related credit in Education
- **Required:** Final year of college in an enrolled teacher prep program majoring in Exceptional Education
- **Preferred:** Proficiency in Microsoft products including: Word, Excel, Power Point and Outlook
- **Preferred:** Experience working with students with and without disabilities

You can be paid during your internship. Paid internships are dependent upon the universities approval.

40 Hours a week

Compensation:

\$15.00/hour
