

Applicant Criteria

There are two Future Teacher Summer Institute Tracks (total 17-20 slots)

- 1. Track 1 Local High school rising junior or seniors interested in being a teacher. Some experience with children (i.e. babysitting, volunteering)
- **2. Track 2** Student in a university teacher prep program with the focus on out of area students/students in HBCU/Hispanic Institutes.
- 1. Track 1 High School Students | 7-10 Total Slots
 - Pay is \$14 hour with limited experience (i.e. babysitting) \$15 hour if applicant has paid classroom experience.
 - No travel costs are covered (expectation is applicant lives local/will drive themselves)
- 2. Track 2 College Students in a Teacher Prep Program | 10 Total Slots for Paid Travel Must be at least 18 years of age
 - Pay is \$15/hour.
 - For students at least 40 miles away UCP will pay for travel costs (flight or mileage) and hotel near the campus from June 2nd June 28th for students
 - **UCP will book/pay for airfare** (coordinate with Alyssa Gomez)
 - **If self-driven -** UCP will reimburse for mileage (57 cents per mile) from home to Orlando with a submission of an expense report form.
 - **Hotel accommodations will be two(2) students per room.** Students can request roommates if they know someone.
 - Participant will be responsible for their own daily transportation to and from the campus (i.e. Uber, self-drive) and any daily living costs (i.e. meals)
